



UNION PACIFIC SD40N LOCOMOTIVE



Union Pacific SD40N locomotives are the product of a modernization program begun by the railroad to upgrade the companies aging fleet of SD40-2 locomotives, some dating back to 1973. The program to convert SD40-2's to SD40N's began in 2011 and is ongoing. The rebuild consists of replacing primary components such as the main generator, traction motors, and air brake equipment as well as rewiring the electrical cabinet. Also included are refurbished cabs, installation of air conditioning, Positive Train Control capability, and the installation of a remanufactured 645E engine. These replacement engines are equipped with a retrofit kit supplied by EMD to bring the locomotive up to Tier 0+ emission standards required by federal mandate on all remanufactured locomotives initially constructed between 1973 and 1992. The N designation is symbolic of Union Pacific using NEXSYS control system from ZTR Control Systems to replace the older Dash 2 system. This improved wheel slip system increases adhesion thereby allowing the locomotive to produce a higher tractive effort. This designation has also been used on MP15's and GP15's featuring the ZTR system. Our model is being offered in six road numbers and will feature either standard fans or Q-fans where appropriate. These new locomotives would make a fine addition to any modern layout.

3281 COVERED HOPPER CAR



The 3281 covered hopper is designed for carrying high density bulk materials. The most commonly carried commodities include sand and cement. These cars were first constructed in the mid 2000's and many thousands of them have been brought into service since then. Current owners of this car include numerous Class 1 railroads like Norfolk Southern and CSX to short lines like Winchester & Western. Many more of these car are operated by a large array of private owners and leasing companies including Cemex, Trinity Industries Leasing and General American.

The InterMountain N scale model of the Trinity 3281 covered hopper will feature all new tooling for the body and roof. The walkway will be etched metal. Separate brake details and wire air lines will be incorporated at the B end of the car. The cars will also include metal wheel sets and truck mounted MicroTrains compatible couplers. Each car will be finished with accurate painting and laser sharp lettering with multiple road numbers in each release. The first ten road names for this commonly seen freight car have been announced, many more will follow.

Rocky Mountain Train Show History

The Rocky Mountain Train Show is held twice a year in Denver, Colorado- the first week in March and the second week in December. At 120,000 square feet and March attendance in the 11,000 range, it is the largest show west of the Mississippi.

The roots of the show began 39 years ago when the Rocky Mountain Division of the Train Collectors Association announced their first "Holiday Meet" to be held Thanksgiving weekend, 1976. The Rocky Mountain Division was the first TCA Division to welcome the public to our shows in the early 1980s.

The show grew to attendance of approximately 2,500, and then, as with many shows, began a decline that saw attendance shrink to approximately 1,200.

In 2009, the club formed a committee to look at solutions to revitalize the show. The decision was to "bet the farm" on moving the show to a world class exhibition facility, The Denver Mart.

To back up this new show, it was determined that we would need to invest in an extensive advertising program. As the show started to grow, we reinvested all profits in additional advertising, which brought additional attendance gains.


