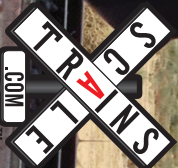

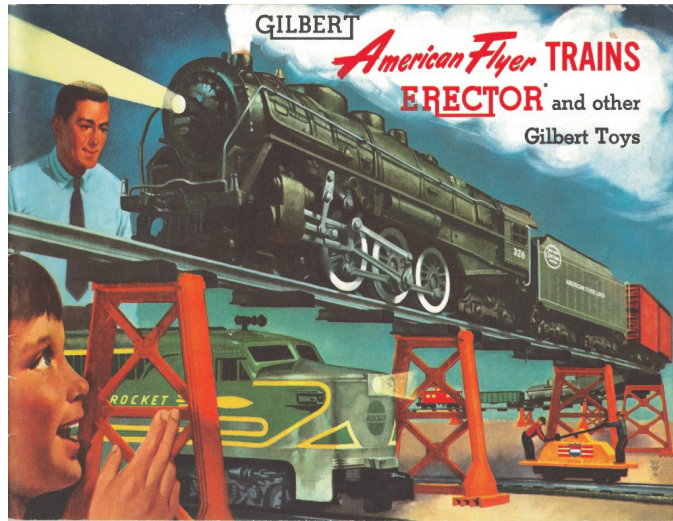

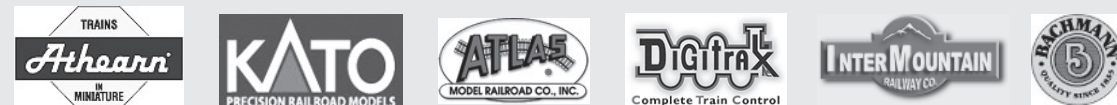

# Rocky Mountain Train Show History

The Rocky Mountain Train Show is held in Denver the first week in March every year. At 120,000 square feet and March attendance in the 11,000 range, it is the largest show west of the Mississippi.

The roots of the show began 39 years ago when the Rocky Mountain Division of the Train Collectors Association announced its first "Holiday Meet" to be held Thanksgiving weekend, 1976. The Rocky Mountain Division was the first TCA Division to welcome the public to our shows in the early 1980s.

Show attendance grew to about 2,500 before, as with many shows, enduring a decline. Attendance dropped to about 1,200 at one point.

In 2009, the club formed a committee to look at solutions to revitalize the show. The decision was to "bet the farm" on moving the show to a world class exhibition facility, The Denver Mart.

To promote the show, an extensive advertising program was deployed. As the show started to grow, we reinvested all profits in additional advertising, which brought more people through the doors.

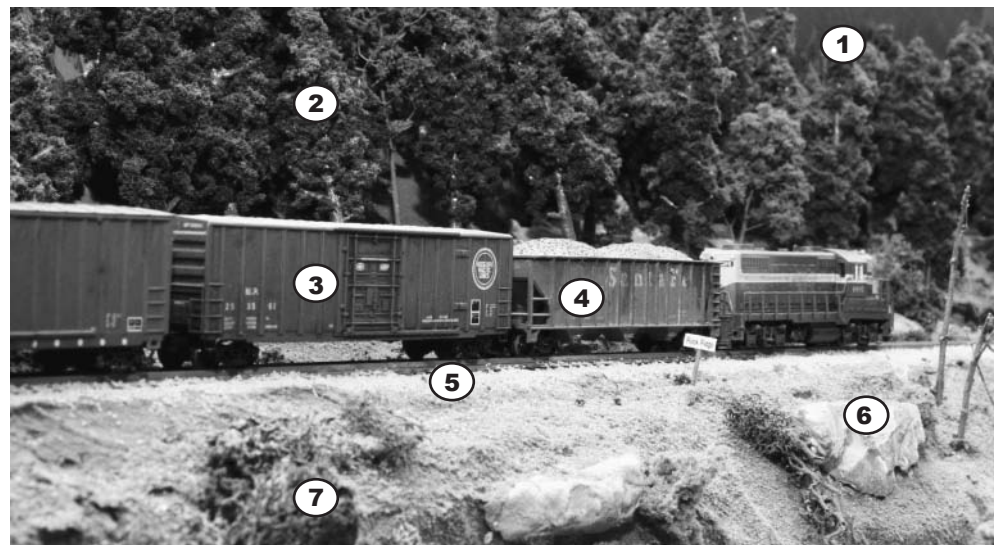
